

JAKKALSVLEI

Area: Herbertsdale
Winemaker: Jantjie Jonker

Jakkalsvlei, directly translated as Jackal's Marsh, is a family owned winery nestled in the beautiful, world famous Garden Route. The Jonker family has been proud owners of Jakkalsvlei since 1972, and today it is farmed by the 3rd generation Jonkers on the farm.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

R90.00

Seamlessly layered flavours ranging from tropical fruit to lime, guava and gooseberry, leading up to a crisp finish. Crisp, fresh, and lively on the palate, with a vibrant tropical grapefruit nose. Long lasting finish.

LA ROSÉ PERLÉ

R90.00

Semi-Sweet

Fragrant, playful, fresh and fun! A refreshing wine with strawberry and watermelon fruit flavours with a hint of effervescence. This unique blend is perfect for sipping while enjoying the warm weather.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Medium bodied with a lovely dark red colour. Rich plum and blackberry aromas. Well integrated toasty oak. Smooth vanilla aftertaste. Light to moderate tannins. The flavours are a balance of oak and fruit, with a core of plum, blackberry, and back notes of vanilla. Overall elegant, with good flavours and soft tannins.

Weltevrede is a Family owned and managed wine estate in the Robertson Wine Valley, close to the town of Bonnievale.

It began when Klaas Jonker purchased the farm in 1912 and planted the first vineyards in the area. He was followed by Japie Jonker, who in 1933 began wine farming on Weltevrede. Today, the tradition is carried on by current owner Philip Jonker.

60% Chardonnay and 40% Pinot Noir Blend. Grapes picked riper to show richness and attractive fruit at an earlier stage. Matured on lees for up to three years. Lively mousse, creamy biscuit on the palate and long aftertaste. A vibrant Cap Classique to celebrate every day.

VANILLA CHARDONNAY **R100.00**

John Platter ★★★

Some taste vanilla. Some get hints of butterscotch or English toffee. Some call it crème brûlée, honey, coconut or crème caramel. Others smell tropical flavours of pineapple, passionfruit or peach. The Vanilla Chardonnay is an expressionistic wine. Tasty Chardonnay Grapes from Karoo limestone terroir are fermented with selected light oak resulting in an alchemy of extraordinary flavour.

CHERRY CHOC MERLOT **R110.00**

The colour is deep red. On the nose you get prominent notes of ripe cherries and chocolate. The mid-palate is chunky with intense flavours of cherries, plums, bitter espresso and a pleasant dry finish of black pepper and dark chocolate.

Spicy aromas with hints of chocolate, coffee and black fruit is forthcoming on the bouquet. These aromas follow through on a silky full body palate, with dried plum and pepper flavours. Complete structure and a full body wine with a well balanced between tannins acidity leaves a lingering taste.

PINOTAGE

The Pinotage has a intense, clean purple colour; aromas of red cherries with a explosion of spices backed by oak, bouquet well carry through on the palate. A medium body with well balance between acidity and tannins.

HARTENBERG SAUVIGNON BLANC R130.00

On the bouquet, intense grassy, green fig aromatics show, as does aromas of tropical fruit. The palate has a vibrant, racy entry that follows through to a long creamy finish.

CHARDONNAY (WOODED) R150.00

Elegant, creamy and zesty with a rich supply of buttery and toasty oak.

RIESLING R120.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Subtly sweet with typical Riesling aromas – floral, honey and a light spice sense – underlined with a hint of soft citrus.

DOORKEEPER SHIRAZ R130.00

John Platter ★★★★★^{1/2}

Saturated, deep black-red. The full aroma displays rich, concentrated spice, chocolate plumminess with violet and savory notes. The wine's palate is rich, yet subtle. The tannins are soft and ripe, but they give a lot of structure. The flavour shows roasted coffee, vanilla toast and a long rich savory aftertaste. Our vineyard soils are able to contribute top quality, full-flavoured richly-structured fruit that is able to dominate the wine.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

R90.00

John Platter ★★★

A wine created in a fruit driven style with passion fruit, gooseberry and hints of guava flavours. Elegant aroma shows tropical characters, integrated with a balanced acidity that adds to the complexity.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

R160.00

John Platter ★★★½

A classic Cabernet with ripe blackberry richness. Dense dark ruby red/black colour with ripe cassis and toasty oak on the nose. Chocolate and black-current fruit flavours mingle with the spicy aroma. Full flavoured palate and firm structure. Supple, yet complex. Well integrated with a generous long finish.

CABERNET MERLOT

(61%)Cabernet Sauvignon, (39%)Merlot. A full-bodied, oak matured red wine with intense deep ruby black colour. Ripe plum, coffee, chocolate and complex toasty oak bouquet. A big concentrated middle palate with long after-taste of fruit, blackberries with undertones of vanilla, mocha and spice.

BLANC

This refreshing white wine is packed with flavours of tropical fruits, Grapefruit, guava, marmalade, lime, honeycomb and hints of candy floss.

MERLOT

Out of the deep garnet colour come the aromas of ripe plum, red cherry and dark chocolate. The palate is balanced with silky tannins and undertones of cured ham.

PINOTAGE

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Clear and bright with a lime green tinge in colour, with complex aromas of crushed fig leaves, guava, gooseberry and granadilla. The palate shows abundant granadilla, asparagus, green bean, and a gooseberry oiliness, accentuated by a juicy, zesty tangerine like citrus finish. The fresh acidity carries the fruit to the back of the palate and prolongs the lingering after-taste.

CHARDONNAY

R130.00

John Platter ★★★½

A bright wine with hints of lime and gold in colour. This Chardonnay has superb and distinctive flavours of citrus and pear with a subtle oak aroma of roasted almonds. The palate and nose are both rich and refreshing with a combination of lime-citrus and white pear flavours. The wine is classically dry, yet luxuriously silky with superb viscosity and length.

CHENIN BLANC

R120.00

John Platter ★★★½

A clear and bright wine with hints of lime and gold. The palate is both rich and refreshing and contains elements of honey, nuts and ripe pineapple and hints of grapefruit. The wine is classically dry, yet luxuriously silky with superb viscosity and length.

TIN MINE WHITE

R120.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Vripe and exotic, a distinctive, spicy wine that is rich and subtly oaked, with a slight aroma of roasted almonds. The Chardonnay gives superb lime-citrus flavors; the Viognier lends a delicate perfume of dried peaches and apricots while the Roussanne and Chenin act like salt and pepper, spicing things up!!

7EVEN BOUQUET BLANC (Off Dry)

John Platter ★★½

Golden colour. A perfumed nose with lots of fruit, floral and spicy aromas. Flavours of litchi, lime and yellow fruit. A complex aromatic wine, with well-balanced sugar and acidity, this wine provides a long crisp finish with layers of fruit and floral tones.

7EVEN ROSÉ (Dry)

A wine with a delicate, beautiful rose petal pink colour. The palate is red fruit - ripe raspberry and strawberry - balanced with sweetness and acidity, giving a long lingering fresh taste. A delicious lifestyle wine, elegant and soft with an off-dry finish.

BORDEAUX (CMC)

R280.00

John Platter ★★½

Rich and generous, this wine boasts a deep dark hue and whiffs of ripe red berries, infused with roasted coffee beans, tobacco leaves, cedar wood and cigar box. On the palate expect concentrated black plum and a decadent dark chocolate finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

R170.00

John Platter ★★★½

The wine is big, bold and full-bodied with intense aromas of black cherries, and blackcurrants with tobacco undertones. Oak aromas are well integrated and add to the complexity of the wine with underlying cedar and cigar box notes. Dark blackberry and plum flavours dominate the palate, followed by hints of cacao. A firm yet well integrated tannin structure and lingering finish.

SHIRAZ

R140.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Warm and vibrant white and black pepper undertones allure you to the mouth-filling flavours of black currant, sweet violet and jasmine spice with finishing hints of white pepper. Its velvety feel leaves you mesmerized. Small amounts of Mourvedrè and Grenache were blended in as the "salt & pepper" with Syrah lending the fruit, spice and backbone with velvety tannin.



NITIDA

Area: Durbanville
Winemaker: RJ Botha

This family owned and run cellar is one of the most consistently awarded and loved boutique wine cellars in South Africa, verified when Nitida was named "Top Producer" at the 2009 Michelangelo International Wine Awards.

SEMILLON "Die Groendruif" R150.00

John Platter ★★★★★^{1/2}

From Asian to French, braaivleis to pizza, this Semillon oozes creamy, fruity food companionship. Loquats walk with honeysuckle and lanolin while lovely dusty, spicy ginger befriends lush macadamia's and light jasmine.

CALLIGRAPHY RED R250.00

John Platter ★★★★★^{1/2}

Velvety cacao, cherry gateau with creamy, smooth sensation. Sunday slow roasted lamb or gemsbok will accentuate basil and origanum freshness. An extraordinary partnership of impressive complexity and accessibility.

CORONATA INTEGRATION WHITE R190.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Surging creamy fusion embroidered with dramatic dulce de leche. Threads of cinnamon butterscotch are woven over sparkling greengage, crisp apples and bamboo shoots.



DIEMERSFONTEIN

Area: Wellington

Winemaker: Francois Roode

Home Of The Original Coffee Chocolate Pinotage.

Diemersfontein has belonged to the Sonnenberg family since the early 1940s, when David's grandfather, Max, bought the 183 hectare farm, which lies in the shadow of the majestic Hawekwa Mountains with a panoramic view of both Du Toit's Kloof and Bains' Kloof.

CHENIN BLANC

A nose of citrus and pineapple, taste of green apples and pears with warm toasty biscuit aromas to add balance good acid lends to this wine's fine length and compatibility with many flavourful dishes.

CARPE DIEM VIOGNIER

R160.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Apricots, orange peel, citrus and biscuit followed by rich round mouth feel with lingering marmalade aftertaste. A brilliant food companion.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

R150.00

John Platter ★★★★★

Good tannin structure. Intense blackcurrent fruit, with undertones of sweet spice, cloves and pepper.

PINOTAGE

On the nose rich dark chocolate, a hint of mint and baked plums. The ripe subtle tannins create a wine to be drunk very young. A unique style of Pinotage.

MAIDEN'S PRAYER RED

Red berries and spicy. Ripe fruit and firm tannins create a wine to be drunk young and cellar for another 2 years. A wine by the glass pleaser. Good before, with or after a meal.



GROOTE POST

Area: Darling
Winemaker: Lukas Wentzel

Groote Post is an historic 18th century farm on the Cape's West Coast where winemaking traditions have been revived by the Pentz family. Unique aspects and cool climatic conditions of the Darling Hills yield superlative fruit. Our wines are produced to reflect the uniqueness of our vineyards.

OLD MANS SPARKLE BRUT ROSÉ

R180.00

John Platter ★★★★★

An elegant salmon-hued Cap Classique with a fine creamy mousse, gorgeous notes of crushed strawberries and raspberries and a silky smoothness on the palate. The Old Man's Sparkle was crafted according to the age-old tradition of a second fermentation in the bottle, which lends a classic yeast and biscuit flavour that lingers on the palate. It was hand-riddled in wooden riddling racks, before disgorging and dosage. Two years in the bottle before release adds complexity and structure to the wine. The Groote Post Old Man's Sparkle Brut Rosé retails for around R97.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

R130.00

John Platter ★★★★★

An explosion of fruit driven by lime, gooseberry and kiwi fruit, is underpinned by a thread of minerality. A lively wine with an intense palate that lingers making this a pleaser for any occasion.

CHENIN BLANC

R100.00

John Platter ★★★★★

A bright, full-styled Chenin with a tropical fruit-salad palate and green apple flavours. A very good length and body.

KAPOKBERG PINOT NOIR

R240.00

John Platter ★★★★★

A more European style Pinot Noir than previous vintages. A dark fruit delivery with dried-beef, savoury flavours. A subtle hint of forest floor underpins the earthy tones characteristic of the cultivar, yielding an elegant and soft wine.
